Little Wandle Letters and Sounds....

The two schools together have adopted a new reading scheme to support the teaching of phonics and very early reading. It's called Little Wandle Letters and Sounds. It is used throughout Park and as an intervention where required in St Peter's. All the staff and initial training on our training days and we have lots of lovely resources ready to share with our children. The initial part of the scheme is assessment-where school staff assess each child to find out what phonetic sounds they know and where the gaps are. Then phonics teaching can really match the needs of each child and reading books can be allocated that really match the children's abilities.

Park have been busy assessing this week-hampered by covid causing some staff and pupil absence. We are nearly ready to start sharing books with our children to take home-they will start next week from Park.

There is much more information coming to you in a separate letter this weekend. Please support the development of reading with your children-it's the most important thing we can do for our young learners. The better we can read-the more we can access around us and the quicker we can learn other things. Reading is the key to learning!



I know that many of you (and your children) like to get into a routine of reading-that's great! Please read books at home-anything and everything that the children love-age appropriate that you'd like to share!
